

BASIC DISC GOLF RULES

OBJECTIVE OF THE GAME

DISC GOLF IS PLAYED LIKE TRADITIONAL "BALL" GOLF, BUT WITH FLYING DISCS INSTEAD OF BALLS AND CLUBS. ONE POINT (STROKE) IS COUNTED EACH TIME THE DISC IS THROWN AND WHEN A PENALTY IS INCURRED. THE PLAYER WITH THE LOWEST TOTAL STROKES FOR THE ENTIRE COURSE WINS.

SAFETY FIRST

NEVER THROW WHEN PLAYERS OR PARK USERS ARE WITHIN RANGE. ALWAYS GIVE PARK USERS THE RIGHT OF WAY. BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS AND ENVIRONMENT.

TEE THROWS

EACH HOLE BEGINS WITH A TEE THROW. TEE THROWS MUST BE COMPLETED WITHIN OR BEHIND THE DESIGNATED TEE AREA.

LIE

THE LIE IS THE SPOT WHERE THE PLAYER'S PREVIOUS THROW HAS LANDED. PLAYERS MUST THROW FROM BEHIND THEIR LIE ON EACH SHOT.

OUT OF BOUNDS (OB)

IF A PLAYER'S LANDS IN OUT OF BOUNDS TERRITORY, THE PLAYER MUST THROW FROM THE LAST PLACE THE DISC WAS IN BOUNDS AND ADD A PENALTY STROKE.
